The Harvest

Method: Hand-picked in 20kg crates
Yield: 8 t/ha
Time: late March

Winemaker: Jacques Fourie
Must treatment: Cold maceration for 4 days
Fermentation: SST Tank

Maturation: 12 months in French oak 20% new, 80% second fill

Bottled: 2013

Release: August 2019
